A: 2010

Q: (i-Tree Eco) Can we work with trees less than 1” DBH?

A: Yes you can!

Q: (i-Tree Eco) Is it possible to estimate air pollution removal in Bangladesh / {any city}?

A: When beginning an Eco project, you will select a weather year. If pollution data is available, it will show “2019 (Weather and pollution)”. There are pathways to use i-Tree in international location, which you can learn about in the [i-Tree Database](#).

Q: (i-Tree Eco) If input data relates to ideal crown areas, what about crowns of urban trees which are often (and badly) pruned?

A: i-Tree Eco allows you to input direct crown measurements from the field to account for pruning, damage, maintenance, and condition.
